



Case Study: Local Credit Union



The Company: Local credit union established in 1957 to provide financial services to members in Cowlitz County and Southwest Washington. The business relies heavily on the use of computers to access and maintain critical financial information for its members.

The Challenge: As a financial institution, the Credit Union is required to ensure security of sensitive and personal financial information. Government regulations require extensive testing to ensure data is secure from internal and external security threats.

The Solution: More Power Computers implemented a proactive managed security services program consisting of comprehensive, periodic penetration and vulnerability testing, coupled with monthly physical security inspections and 24/7 vital parameter monitoring. Routine security audits are performed, and reports are generated identifying security concerns which are then corrected. Regular preventative maintenance is performed to ensure all network hardware is operating at peak performance.

The Result: After implementation of the MoreCare program, several security concerns were identified and corrected, for example many workstations were missing critical security updates and were open to viral attacks. Regular strategy and planning meetings identified processes to promote greater efficiency in the use of the network which resulted in increased staff productivity while still maintaining security throughout the organization.
